**Australian Evidence- Based Clinical Practice Guideline for Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder**

An announcement for folks who work with children or young people experiencing symptoms consistent with ADHD, from GMA investigator, Professor Mark Bellgrove: The Australian ADHD Professionals Association (AADPA) has announced that it has made available an evidence-based clinical practice guideline for ADHD, launched on the 5th of October 2022.

The Guideline has been approved by the Australian National Health and Medical Research Council (NHMRC) following a rigorous peer-review process and has been endorsed by major medical and allied health professional colleges and organizations.
