GMA Annual Scientific Meeting - Meeting of the Minds 2024

GMA is excited to announce that after conducting our project virtually since our project commenced in 2021, our Scientific Investigators, Early and Mid Career researchers and Operations team will finally be able to collaborate and meet in person. The Growing Minds Feeling Good study aims to develop a digital family-focused intervention for families with children and young people (4-24 years old) taking antipsychotic medications. The intervention incorporates physical activity, diet, sleep, and smoking habit components to promote healthy lifestyles and boost the youngsters' physical and overall well-being. The team is currently in the co-design phase of the intervention, collaborating with intervention experts and parents of children with neurodevelopmental
